Jazz: Denver's best jazz club you don't know about

Tonight. The jazz scene is on an upswing in Denver: new clubs, aspiring local artists and terrific sideshows that give the environment its depth. These days, the most interesting offering might be the **Fresh Jazz & Crisp Vinyl Series** at the **Dikeou Pop-Up Space** on East Colfax Avenue, which has its 14th installment tonight. The series is raw and unconstrained, and unlike the new, pricey clubs downtown, free, unpolished and experimental, making it a good venue for **S.M.R.T.**, an entity that's been defining music as it goes along. Anything from pure jazz to funk to electronic music could be in store. Plus, there will be a DJ spinning selections from the space's exhaustive collection of vinyl.
